Fathers

Profits from his growing business allowed Mohammad to rebuild his family's home, which was destroyed by bombs.

Mama Nzuzi Georgine's youngest son no longer spends his days working in the family business since his family can now afford to send him to school.

The Disabled

Wang Hai Ming, who is legally blind, received a loan from HOPE to start a business selling tofu. He now employs seven people.

The Lost

Bao Liu was a member of a cult. Through a relationship with her HOPE loan officer she discovered new life in Christ and left the cult.

HOPE works with people in need regardless of their race, religion, gender, age, or marital status.

HOPE International empowers the world’s poor to create a *Permanent Solution* to poverty.

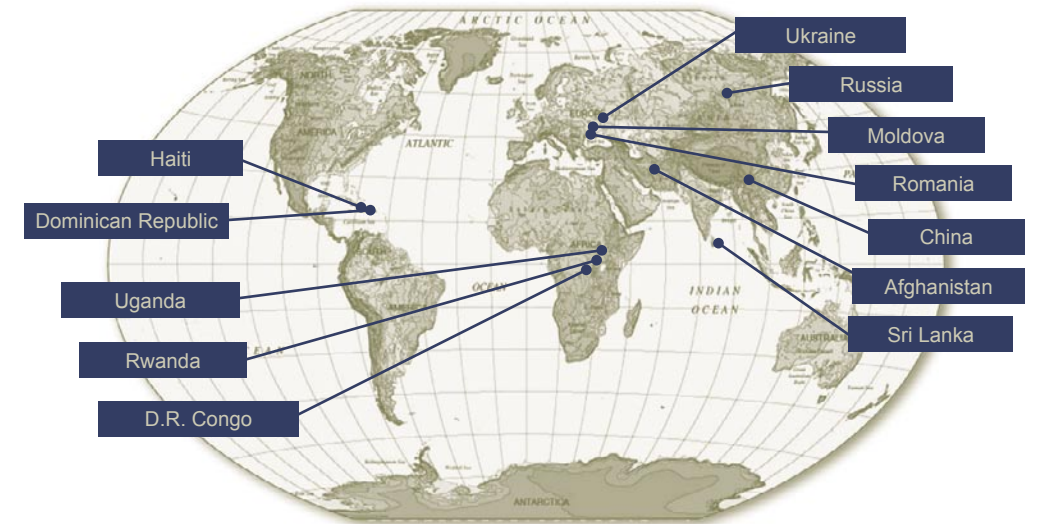
Permanent Solutions

Combining expertise in microfinance with a passion for sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ, HOPE seeks to alleviate physical and spiritual poverty around the world. Through HOPE’s microfinance programs, individuals living in poverty receive small loans to start or expand their own businesses. As loan cycles progress, the loans are repaid and the money is lent out again and again. Over 99% of all HOPE’s loans are repaid, creating a self-sustaining cycle that impacts thousands of lives over time. HOPE’s approach offers a *permanent solution* designed to provide a “hand up” not a “hand out,” empowering people to lift themselves out of poverty. Recognizing that lasting hope comes not from financial security but from a relationship with Christ, HOPE’s loan officers seek to share the Gospel with their clients. Whenever possible, HOPE works in conjunction with the local church.



Worldwide Reach

HOPE currently serves people living in 12 countries worldwide.

Children’s Ministries

HOPE also supports culturally-appropriate and effective children’s ministries in addition to microfinance. These programs are typically carried out in collaboration with the local church. In Ukraine, HOPE operates 300 children’s clubs and 100 summer camps that present the Gospel message to over 10,000 children each year.
